A baby born at 21 weeks gestation was recognized by Guinness World Records in 2025 as the most premature baby ever to survive. He weighed just 10 ounces at birth.

Percentage of abortions performed on teens. Maryland lacks sufficient safeguards to prevent a minor girl from being taken for a secret abortion without a parent's knowledge.

Anywhere from 60-90% of babies diagnosed with Down syndrome are aborted.

Percentage of abortions that are performed because the pregnancy is the result of sexual assault or incest.

57%

Percentage of Americans who oppose their tax dollars being used to pay for abortions. 73% oppose tax dollars being used to pay for abortions in foreign countries.

Percentage of Maryland abortions that are chemical abortions. Some abortionists prescribe lethal abortion drugs via webcam without ever seeing the woman in person.
